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LEGAL LIABILITY

1. By signing this entry form, participants accept that they are responsible for themselves, their crew, and their boats whether afloat or ashore.
2. Nothing done by the race / rally organisers will relieve participants of their responsibilities.
3. By putting to sea participants imply the suitability of their vessel and the competence of the skipper and crew for the expected or forecast conditions.
4. The presence of patrol boats / committee boats does not relieve participants of their responsibilities.
5. The safety of a yacht and her entire management, including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/skipper who must ensure the yacht is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy, and manned by a crew sufficient in number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather. The owner/skipper must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails, and all gear. He must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date, and that the crew know where it is kept and how to use it.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be issued with an event pack at the skippers briefing. This will be at 2000hrs (prompt) Saturday 29th May 2010 in the I.Y.C. clubhouse, all skippers (*only*) and officials are required to attend.

HARBOUR DUES

The Harbour master will be at the IYC club house from 1900 - 2000 on Saturday 29th May 2010 (*the hour preceding the skippers briefing*) to collect harbour dues at a discounted rate.

Harbour Dues are payable at all times when moored or at anchor within the Harbour Authority Area.

The discounted rate for entrants is £5.00 per night for vessels up to 25'
 £7.50 per night for vessels over 25' but less than 30'
 £10.00 per night for vessels over 30'

The Harbour master has asked that any vessel anchored in the outer harbour must show an anchor light during the hours of darkness.

I have read the Notice of Rally/Race and confirm that I agree to its provisions and that my vessel will conform to its requirements throughout the event.
